Footnotes

DARING DANCER broke outwardly, settled off of the inside in mid pack, took closer order through the second turn, was bottled up entering the stretch, steadied near the three-sixteenths marker, split rivals and kicked away once clear. SWEET ACCLAIM (IRE) settled off of the inside at the back of the pack, swung six wide entering the stretch, came to level terms with a furlong to run but was out kicked. RECEPTA was unhurried into stride, responded when roused near the seven-sixteenths pole, made a sweeping move five wide, loomed large entering the stretch but flattened during the drive. KITTEN KABOODLE disputed the pace three wide, but weakened between rivals in the final furlong and gave way. ANNULMENT attended the pace five wide, was within striking distance entering the stretch but faltered in the drive and faded. LACAROLINA (FR) set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed entering the stretch, was jostled near the three-sixteenths pole and came up empty thereafter. ZINZAY was close up four wide to the stretch, but was engulfed between horses and retreated. FALSE CLOCK failed to respond. BABE'S RULER broke in the air, tucked in to save ground but was never a factor.
