DARING DANCER settled on the inside, cut the corner while roused into the stretch, moved out under a left-handed whip, switched to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker, rallied on the outside, closed strongly to draw alongside the runner-up, was switched back to a left-handed whip late and narrowly prevailed in a beautiful ride. A LITTLE BIT SASSY tracked the pace on the outside, inched closer on the far turn, was set down in upper stretch, took a short lead into the final furlong, led until the shadow of the wire but was denied. DARING KATHY had the rider adjust his right iron after the start, went to the front, set the pace on the inside, was asked near the quarter-pole, battled into the final sixteenth while under a right-handed whip and was outfinished while able to get the show. SWEET ACCLAIM (IRE) saved ground on the first turn, settled at the back, was ridden along in the two path on the far turn and finished willingly. SPEED SEEKER was taken in hand early, raced off the rail on the first turn, was rated on the outside, came under urging while in the two path on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. DUFF ONE saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced inside on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed kick. LITTLE JOURNEY (FR) raced off the rail on the first turn, settled on the outside but was given cover, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. (Rail at 9 Feet)
