SEA QUEEN kept watch on PARTY NOW while taking the inside route, continued along on the same scenario to the quarter pole, got cued up and angled sharply into the three path nearing the three-sixteenths marker, took off in earnest for the lead after completing the move, steadily cut into the deficit, gained the advantage in the final seventy yards and edged away. MINORETTE strung out three wide on the opening bend, continued from off the inside down the backstretch, was let out a notch and unleashed a menacing run leaving the three-eighths pole, arrived at the head of the stretch well within striking distance, took over before completing the next furlong, offered good resistance before getting caught with under a sixteenth remaining. RECEPTA along the inside during the short run leading to the first turn, tipped into the two path, stalked the leader while being rated, got put to urging coming to the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed response. PARTY NOW three wide heading for the beginning of the first turn, took control and was along the rail by its end, rated kindly while showing the way, facing no resistance for nearly six furlongs, was asked for a response heading home, yielded soon afterwards and backed away. DARING DANCER well off the inside throughout, launched a three wide on the far turn to scurry into contention, fanned into the four path entering the stretch, was flattening out by the furlong marker. LAWN PARTY quickly sent over to the rail, failed to respond when asked to at the half mile pole.
